

Ramthakur college creates history among 24 Govt. Degree Colleges

Agartala February 21,2019: Formation of placement cell in the 24 Govt. Degree Colleges on June 2018 was truly an appreciative effort of the newly formed state government and it was first proved by the Placement Cell of Ramthakur College through a workshop cum audition held on Feb 20, 2019, organized by the Scamper Technologies & services Pvt. Ltd.

Two celebrities namely Mr.Koushik Bhattacharjee (Actor & Trainer) & Ms Tamori Chaudhuri (Professional Modeller, Zee Bangla) were present in the workshop introduced as 'Free Career Workshop Cum Audition' as

mentors. The workshop offered different professional Diploma / Certificate courses like Diploma in creative acting, Diploma news presentation, Professional singing courses, Professional Dancing course, Professional Modeling course, TET 1 & 2 etc.

248 students participated in the workshop in which 23 students were present in the Audition round in which six students got selected by the organizers. Ms. Puja Roy, Semester II of Eng (H) got spot selection as a news anchor in Bengali news channel **'Social Bangla'** in this audition. The five other students got 25% scholarship under different professional Diploma / Certificate courses conducted by the Scamper Technologies & Services Pvt. Ltd.

Placement cell of RTC was formed in June 2018 and till now RTC has not received any fund from the department of Higher Education to conduct any workshop. In a selfless bid to implement the state government's initiative Dr. Arijit Das, convener of the placement cell, first conducted such placement related workshop cum audition among all 24 government degree colleges through self financing for the benefit of the students and created history among all 24 Govt. Degree colleges in Tripura.

In his speech Dr Arijit Das said that this type of workshop cum audition conducted by firms dealing in different types of business and services help students reach and identify their career destinations in accordance with their aspirations, flair and potential. 'The state government launched a very positive and constructive initiative last year and this is now bearing fruit; it is good that Ram Thakur College is the first institution to have organized such a programme; I am sure in future other institutions will also follow suit and students will benefit from this' said **Dr Arijit Das.**
