

New SERB-DST sponsored laboratory in Ramthakur college opened

Agartala, Jan 30, 2014 : For the first time in the forty seven yearold history of Ramthakur College a separate and new laboratory sponsored by the Science and Education Research Board (SERB) under the union Department of Science and Technology (DST) was formally launched today by the college principal Ms Juthika Bhattacharjee in a simple function. The laboratory which cost an overhead charge of Rs 2 lakhs sanctioned by the SERB-DST will be under the care of principal investigator and Tripura's internationally acclaimed Chemistry scholar Dr Arijit Das who will carry out research on 'Synthesis of Mixed Ligand Complex and its Luminescent Properties and Biological Activity Studies'. Dr Arijit Das was assigned the Rs 12 lakh project which is slated to be completed within a stipulated period of two years. A research fellow , already appointed for assisting the project, is joining on February 1.

The separate laboratory designated as 'Synthetic Inorganic Research Laboratory' was formally launched today in a simple programme by the principal of the college Ms Juthika Bhattacharjee in presence of professors Aparna Das and Indrani Chakraborty who is the secretary of the teachers council in the college. Ms Bhattacharjee who secured accreditation of Ramthakur college from the national accreditation committee (NAC) of UGC congratulated Dr Arijit Das on his innovative research on chemistry and expressed the hope that the project would be a grand success.
